Challenges

- Climate variability and change pose significant economic, health, and environmental risks
- Extreme climate events cause substantial losses of life and property each year
- Climate Change scenarios project an increase in frequency of severe weather events, rising sea levels, and warming temperatures
- There is a gap between currently available climate change information that is based on global, long-term simulations, and the shortterm, local information that decision makers need in order to evaluate options for mitigating and adapting to climate change

Goals

- Promote effective partnerships among universities, government and industry
- Develop and foster an international network of multi-disciplinary scientific expertise on climate change and societal response options
- Identify and meet future strategic research and education needs
- Predict climate variability and change, including sea level rise, through the application of computer simulation
- Develop effective decision support systems
- Disseminate reliable, scientifically sound, regionally aggregated information and data
